- 1. Describe Roosevelt's expression in this photo. What impression does it give of him as a leader?
- 2. Use the poster, your textbook, and online resources to find other photos of Roosevelt taken during his presidency. How do the images help you understand President Roosevelt as an individual and a president?

- 3. What three nations did these leaders represent? What offices did Joseph Stalin and Winston Churchill hold in 1943?
- 4. Why would the leaders of these three nations meet in 1943?
- 5. Why is this photograph included on a poster about Roosevelt's presidential vision?

6. Describe what is happening in each photo.

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- 7. Look closely at the photograph of the farmer. What can you learn about him and his life from the photograph? Explain your answer.

- 9. Why are these two photographs included on a poster about Roosevelt's presidential vision?
