

A President's Vision Student Poster Contest: Registration Form

Students may select any U.S. president. Posters may be paper-based or digital. As with the posters Humanities Texas developed, each student's poster should identify the "presidential vision" of a U.S. president and use explanatory text and primary sources to illustrate how that president pursued that vision during his term(s).

Eligibility: Any Texas student in grade 6-12 may enter the competition.
