**TERRI PANTUSO** entered the teaching profession in 1992 as an English I & II Teacher in San Antonio ISD and spent over thirteen years teaching in Texas secondary schools. She received her PhD in English language and literatures from The University of Texas at San Antonio in 2009. She joined the English department at Texas A&M University in 2017 where she served as Freshman Composition Coordinator until July 2020, when she became assistant dean for Assessment and Curricular Matters to the College of Arts & Sciences at TAMU. Dr. Pantuso co-authored a peer-reviewed open educational resource (OER) textbook, which is provided to students enrolled in sections of ENGL 104 at no cost and received the Instruction Section Innovation Award from the Association of College and Research Libraries (ACRL) in 2020. She works on open-access materials for writing courses on behalf of the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board and has won awards for her work in OER from the Student Government Association and Provost's Office. In 2022, she received the Provost APT Faculty Teaching Excellence award. Her research interests focus on open and equitable pedagogy, writing instruction, and American women writers. In addition to composition, Dr. Pantuso teaches courses on women writers and writing about literature. In her spare time, she is a mother to three adult daughters and two feisty felines.

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
