Teaching Dystopian Literature

This webinar will explore major, commonly taught works of dystopian fiction and offer strategies for teaching them at the secondary level.

SÉAN P. CONNORS is an associate professor of English education in the College of Education and Health Professions at the University of Arkansas. His scholarship and teaching focus on the application of diverse critical perspectives to young adult literature. He is the editor of *The Politics of Panem*, a collection of critical essays on the *Hunger Games* trilogy, and co-editor of *Teaching Girls on Fire: Essays on Dystopian Young Adult Literature in the Classroom*. His most recent book, *Neoliberalism and Young Adult Fiction*, examines the econo-politics of literature for teenagers.
