JAMES H. COX is the Jane and Roland Blumberg Centennial Professor of English at The University of Texas at Austin. His primary research interests include twentieth and twenty-first century American literature, especially Native American and immigration literature. He has published three books on Native American literature and co-edited *The Oxford Handbook of Indigenous American Literature*, which won the 2014–2015 MLA Prize for Studies in Native American Literatures, Languages, and Cultures. He has won four teaching awards, including both the President's Associates Teaching Excellence Award and The Regents' Outstanding Teaching Award in 2009. Cox was inducted into the Academy of Distinguished Teachers in 2017.
